Essential Question

Why do different animals have different body parts?

Objectives

- 1. Know definition of adaptation and learn some examples of adaptations.
- 2. Know why adaptations are important and how they help a species to thrive.

Vocabulary

Adaptation: The ways animal species adjust or change to be able to live where and how they do. Many species can only live in certain places because of their specific adaptations.

Environment: The surrounding habitat with features an animal needs to survive.


