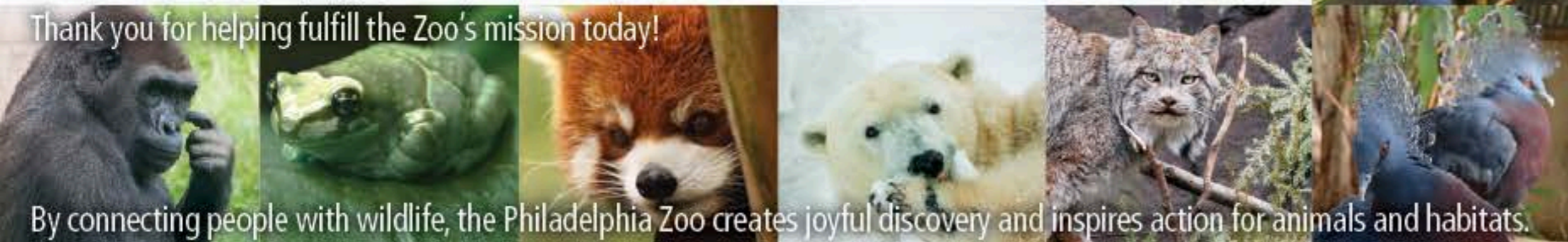

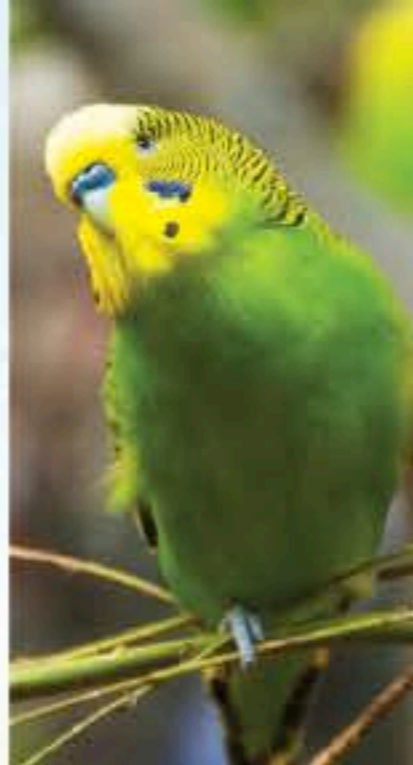
## Zoo Etiquette
