If it is too loud, I can wear headphones or cover my ears.


If something smells bad, I can hold my nose or cover my nose with something that smells good.

#### Line at Rainforest Carousel

We might have to wait in line for the ride.

While we wait, I will hear music playing, announcements from the carousel and the bell ringing when the ride starts and ends.

I may also hear other sounds from around the Zoo, like other families walking around or even a train passing by.



### Riding the Carousel

After our tickets get scanned, I will pick which animal I want to ride. It is important that I buckle the seat belt my parent or guardian can help me make sure it fits well.

If I am under 40" inches tall, one adult can ride with me without their own ticket. If my parent or guardian doesn't ride with me, might ride alone. If that happens I will be able to see my parent or guardian as I ride the carousel.



### Riding the Carousel

After I am all buckled up, I will hear an announcement that will tell me to stay seated until the ride is over.

Then I will hear a bell ring and the ride will start moving.

My animal will start going up and down as the carousel will spin around and around. The ride will take about 3 minutes. Once the ride is about to stop, I will hear another announcement asking me to stay seated.



#### Leaving the Carousel

Once the carousel stops ,I can unbuckle my seat belt and get off my animal. If I need help, the operator can let an adult in to help me out.

After I get off my animal, the operator will open a different gate from where I entered.

After I exit the carousel, I can either keep exploring the Zoo or go home. What a great day at the Philadelphia Zoo!
